Pain Management

Neck, Back, and Spine Care

 Joint injections with steroids, nerve root block (blockade), fluoroscopically-guided spine injections, ultrasound-guided injections, radiofrequency ablation, spinal cord stimulator trial & implantation, nueromodulation, epidural injection, trigger point injection

Shoulder Care

 Joint injections with steroids, nerve root block (blockade), and radiofrequency ablation

Hip Care

 Joint injections with steroids, fascia iliaca blocks, and greater trochanteric bursa injection

Knee Care

 Joint injections with steroids or viscosupplementation, genicular nerve blockade, peripheral nerve stimulation (PNS), and radiofrequency ablation

Foot Care

 Non-invasive treatments and injections for plantar fasciitis, peripheral nerve blocks, and neuromodulation, neuropathy treatments

Additional Specialities and Treatments

- Headaches including cervicogenic headaches, migraines and occipital neuralgia
- Complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS) care, including sympathetic plexus blockade
