Documentation Needs:

- Left or Right
- Weight bearing status – **must be ambulatory in some capacity**
- What weakness does the patient have
- What deformity is present
- Is there instability or laxity
- Which product are they receiving
- How are they to use the product
 - Wear at all times
 - During ambulation
 - Only at night
 - Remove for hygiene only
- How are they going to benefit from using it
 - Stabilization
 - Improve function
 - Reduce pain
 - Facilitate healing

Possible Diagnosis:

There are not any diagnosis limitations however you cannot use pain.
Common diagnosis used would be:

- Ankle sprains and strains
- Foot sprains and strains
- Fractures of the foot
- Fractures of the ankle
- Post ORIF for fracture
- Post tendon/ligament repair
- Achilles tendon ruptures
