

## ICD-10 CODES | NERVE | PERIPHERAL NERVE LESIONS AND COMPRESSION

### 1. Spine Related

- a. Cervical Root Disorders extra spinal
- b. Thoracic Root Disorders extra spinal
- c. Intercostal neuropathy
- d. Lumbosacral root disorders extra spinal

### 2. Upper Extremity

- a. Thoracic Outlet Syndrome
- b. Radial Nerve Compression, upper limb
- c. Ulnar Nerve Compression, upper limb
- d. Carpal Tunnel Syndrome
- e. Other lesions of median nerve
- f. Brachial plexitis
- g. Complex Regional Pain Syndrome upper limb (previously RSD)
- h. Nerve root compression secondary to other diseases, eg tumors

### 3. Lower Extremity

- a. Sciatic Nerve Compression, extra spinal (e.g. Piriformis syndrome, hamstring syndrome)
- b. Meralgia Paresthetica
- c. Lesion of Femoral Nerve
- d. Lesion of Lateral Popliteal Nerve (previously Peroneal Nerve Palsy)
- e. Lesion of Medial Popliteal Nerve
- f. Tarsal Tunnel Syndrome
- g. Lesion of Plantar Nerve
- h. Complex Regional Pain Syndrome Lower Limb (previously RSD)

### 4. Other Nerve Lesions, non compressive

- a. Complex Regional Pain Syndrome of Upper or Lower Limb
- b. Mononeuropathies Secondary to:
  - i. Diabetes, Syphilis, TB, other
- c. Polyneuropathies Secondary to:
  - i. Idiopathic, heredity, diabetes, Charcot Marie Tooth disease, drug induced, alcoholic, Lyme, RA
